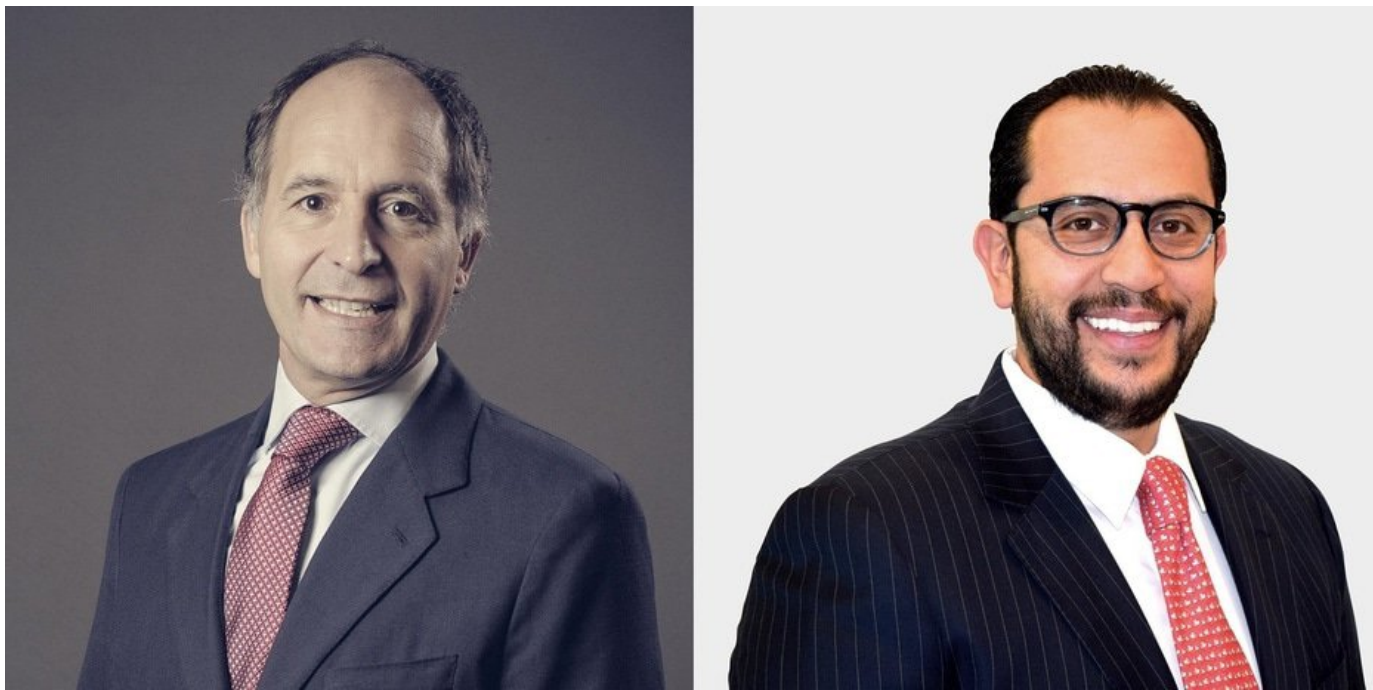


Law firm network WSG appoints Argentine chairman

The World Services Group (WSG) has appointed Ramón Moyano of Argentina's [Beccar Varela](#) and Jesús Colunga of Mexico's [Basham, Ringe y Correa](#) as members of its board of directors for 2020-21.

Moyano was appointed chairman, while Colunga became director. The election took place over a two-day virtual event on 16 and 17 September. Moyano replaced outgoing chairman Michael Bernard of US firm Dykema. WSG has had several Latin American chairmen in the past.

Each member law firm has a representative casting their vote in the election. The chairman sits for one year, while directors are elected for a four-year term. The board has five officers, including the chairman and a chairman elect, as well as 10 directors. Pedro Aguiar de Freitas of Brazil's [Veirano Advogados](#) is already among the other directors.

WSG has over 120 member firms across some 150 jurisdictions. It serves as a platform to create relationships and business opportunities for its members, which are predominantly law firms but also investment banks and accounting firms. The group was founded in 2002.
